



Coronavirus Survey Results

Thank you to everyone who completed the survey. The survey ran from Wednesday, March 18th to Saturday, March 21st. It's a great snapshot of what's happening in our industry right now.

1636 nannies completed the survey total. I've summarized the results below. The survey was divided into sections based on types of nannies so only full-time nannies answered the questions in that section, only part-time nannies with one job answered the questions in that section and so on. In the first column is the percentage of respondents based on the percentage that completed that individual question, not the survey in full. In the second column is the total number of respondents that chose that answer to the question.
